


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Fun. Awesome Scripture Time!


I. Psalms II7; II8:28; I46:I, 5-9

As a family, praise the Lord with song! Select your favorite Primary songs, or have your children help you pick their favorites. Then, sing them together! We suggest that you include "All Creatures of Our God and King" (Hymns, pg. 62) and any other songs that praise the Lord.



3. Psalms 121 & 122

Read the scriptures, then practice how to show thanks for all the Lord has done for you by praying. Teach your children how to pray. "We bow our heads, close our eyes, fold our arms, and use special language..." Talk about how it's important to be reverent when you pray. Say a family prayer together or encourage your children to say a personal prayer. You could also learn "We Bow Our Heads" (Children's Songbook, pg. 25a).



2. Psalm 119:105

Light a candle and read this scripture, or do your whole family scripture study by candlelight. Discuss how the word of the Lord (the scriptures) are a lamp or light to your family's path. How does light help you? How does the word of the Lord help you?
