- ☐ **Parents:** Read Isaiah 53:1.

Children: This chapter is a prophecy of Christ's life, trials, and atonement. Use the scripture story sticker of Christ's atonement to place by the heading of this chapter.

- ☐ **Parents:** Read Isaiah 53:2.

Children: Use the scripture story sticker of the plant in dry ground. What does it mean to "root out of dry ground?" See 2 Nephi 10:3-5. This explains the world that Christ would live in.

- ☐ **Parents:** In verse 2 it says, "no beauty that we should desire Him." What does this mean?

Children: Cut the quote out from Bruce R. McConkie explain this and glue it in your scriptures.

"There was nothing about [Jesus] to cause people to single him out. In appearance he was like men; and so it is expressed here by the prophet that he had no form or comeliness, that is, he was not so distinctive, so different from others that people would recognize him as the Son of God. Children: Color the picture of Christ as our shepherd.

Children: Use the scripture story sticker of the lamb by this verse.

- ☐ **Parents:** Read Isaiah 53:8-9.

Children: Use the scripture story sticker of the crosses on Calvary by these verses.

- ☐ **Parents:** Read Isaiah 53:11.

Children: Use the scripture story guide of the scripture reference, "Matthew 26-28." In Matthew 26-28, Christ fulfills all of the prophecies Isaiah talks about in this chapter.

- ☐ **Parents:** Read Isaiah 53: 12.

Children: This says that Christ will receive a portion and a spoil. This is referring to Eternal Life. It also teaches that Christ will share that with the strong. We can be the strong. Draw a picture of you standing with Christ below.

- ☐ **Parents and Children:** Now turn to Mosiah 14. Compare what you just read to this chapter in the Book of Mormon.
