After reading and singing the song, play “follow the leader” around your house and give everyone in your family a chance to be the leader. Relate this to following the prophet. The prophet is the leader of The Church on earth and helps us to know what Heavenly Father would have us do. We should always try to do what the prophet asks us to. We can look to him for guidance and direction in our lives.
