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Deepening Our Conversion

Luke 22:31-34; 54-62 and John 18:17-27

As a family read Luke 22:31-34; 54-62 and John 18:17-27.

Activities for Families

As a family discuss the story of when Peter denies Christ. Help your children understand that Peter was one of Christ’s Apostles, who loved Christ and felt he was ready to do anything to serve and follow Christ, but still under social pressure he denied knowing who Christ was. Teach your family the importance of deepening our conversion to the Lord. Discuss what it means to be converted, emphasize the importance of the daily work it takes to strengthen our conversion and build our testimonies. Conversion is a process that we build line upon line. It is important to make the conscious effort to choose God daily. Discuss what social pressures we feel that can make us scared of standing up for what we believe and how we can deepen our conversion to withstand those pressures. Point out to your family that Christ brings us joy and denying Christ brings us sadness.

As a family put together the Clock activity and have each person write the little things they can do throughout the day to deepen their conversion to the Lord. Have everyone write theirs on the clock. Find a place to display the clock to remind you throughout the week that it takes daily action to deepen our conversion and strengthen our testimonies.



Daily Conversion Clock

Luke 22:31-34; 54-62 and John 18:17-27

Use a brad to attach the hour and minute hand to the clock. For each hour of the day (AM in the outer circle, PM in the inner circle), write what things you can do to strengthen your testimony of the Savior. Hang it up to remind you throughout the week to continually work on your conversion.
