PRINTING

The majority of our downloads are formatted to print on 8.5x11" paper, unless otherwise noted. You may print at home or at a local print shop. We recommend using a recent version of Adobe Acrobat PDF Reader to view and print your files. It is available for free online. If you run into problems with pages being cut off, select "fit to page" in your print dialogue box to make sure it fits on your page correctly.

To print large page sizes (anything larger than 8.5x11"), we recommend going to a local print shop like Kinko's, Staples, AlphaGraphics, etc. and ask them to print your file as a black and white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big and fun, and fairly inexpensive.

If the staff at your print shop asks you about your rights to reproduce this work, you will find a copyright release below. Or you can tell them you downloaded these files for personal use from comefollowmefhe.com and they can look us up to see you do have rights to print the copies.

Scripture Story Guide

for kids

The Empty Tomb Matthew 28:1-7, Mark 16:1-11, Luke 24:1-12 and John 20:1-10

This week we are going to study the same event in the Four Gospels. Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John each recorded about the Resurrection of the Savior and we will read each account from their different perspectives. First we are going to give you the marking guide for each chapter, then at the end we will color coordinate a little explanation with each chapter

Matthew 28:1-7

Verse 1

○ Vs 1: Underline "Mary Magdalene" and "the other Mary" and place the sticker of the two women over or next to verse 1.

Verses 2-4

○ Vs 2: Draw a squiggly line under "earthquake" and underline "the angel of the Lord descended" and "rolled back the stone."

Verses 5-7

○ Put a bracket around verses 4-7 and write "Angel" next to the bracket.

○ Vs 5-6: Underline "Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified." Underline all of verse 6.

○ Vs 7: Put a box around "go quickly" and "Galilee." Underline "tell his disciples" and "there shall ye see him."

Mark 16:1-11

Verses 1-2

○ Vs 1: Underline "Mary Magdalene" and "Mary the mother of James." Place the spices sticker next to or over "sweet spices."

Verse 3

Verses 5-7

○ Vs 4: Underline "the stone was rolled away."

○ Put a bracket around verses 5-7 and write "Angel" next to the bracket.

○ Vs 9: Underline "Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene" and place the sticker of resurrected Jesus over or next to verse 9.

Luke 24:1-12

Verses 1-3

○ Vs 1: Underline "they."

Verses 4

○ Vs 4: Place the sticker of the two angels next to or over verse 4.

Verses 5-7

○ Put a bracket around 4-7 and write "Angel" next to the bracket.

Verses 9-10

○ Vs 9-10: Underline "Mary Magdalene," "Joanna," "Mary the mother of James" and "other women."

John 20:1-10

Verses 1

○ Vs 1: Underline "Mary Magdalene."

Verses 2-10

○ Vs 7: Place the empty tomb with a linen cloth sticker over or next to verse 7.

RED: After the Sabbath was over Mary Magdalene, Mary (the mother of James), and other women rose early to go to the tomb to finish the preparation of the Saviors' crucified body.

Yellow: Two angels came down from heaven. The guards who had been placed there by the Jewish priest, so that no one would steal Jesus' body, are afraid and run away. The angels rolled the stone away from the entrance of the tomb and sat on it.

Blue: The small group of women arrive at the tomb with spices to anoint and prepare the Savior's body for burial. They see that the large stone in front of the tomb has been rolled away and there are two angels sitting at the tomb. They are surprised and afraid. The angels tell them not to be afraid, that Jesus is Risen!

Green: Mary Magdalene quickly leaves to tell the disciples that the tomb is empty and that the angels have told them Jesus is Risen! The disciples are confused and rush to the tomb to see for themselves. They find the linen cloth Jesus' body was wrapped in and the empty tomb.
