PRINTING

The majority of our downloads are formatted to print on 8.5x11" paper, unless otherwise noted. You may print at home or at a local print shop. We recommend using a recent version of Adobe Acrobat PDF Reader to view and print your files. It is available for free online. If you run into problems with pages being cut off, select "fit to page" in your print dialogue box to make sure it fits on your page correctly.

To print large page sizes (anything larger than 8.5x11"), we recommend going to a local print shop like Kinko's, Staples, AlphaGraphics, etc. and ask them to print your file as a black and white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big and fun, and fairly inexpensive.

If the staff at your print shop asks you about your rights to reproduce this work, you will find a copyright release below. Or you can tell them you downloaded these files for personal use from comefollowmefhe.com and they can look us up to see you do have rights to print the copies.

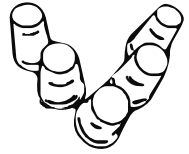
Christ is the Cornerstone

You will need 15 cups. Cut out and attach the apostles to 14 of these cups. (You will need to put two apostles on one of the cups.)

Attach Christ to the 15th cup.

Start with 5 cups in a V shape.

Stack the cups into a tower with Christ on the bottom in the middle.



Explain that Christ is the cornerstone of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Cornerstones help keep buildings up. If a building doesn't have a cornerstone, it will fall.

Remove Christ from the stack, and it will fall. Like the tower depends on the foundation of Christ, we depend on Christ to lead our church through the prophet. We need to build our faith and testimony on Christ.



Teaching Tip: Music is a powerful teaching tool! Use it often. Begin lessons with songs and use hymns as lullabies at bedtime. Try to find a hymn that matches what you're learning each week.
