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


# FAST

FUN, AWESOME SCRIPTURE TIME!

## 1. Genesis 24:1-28

Read the story of Rebekah and how she was chosen as Isaac's wife. Get a pitcher and a 1/8 measuring cup (or small cup) for everyone in your family. Have everyone take a turn filling their cup with water and pouring it into the pitcher while sharing acts of service they can give to others, just like Rebekah gave service. Keep going until you "fill" the pitcher with acts of service.



## 2. Genesis 25:29-34

Gather items from around your house or find pictures of spiritual and worldly things to play a "This or That" game. For example, have your family decide between a picture of the temple or ice cream, Heavenly Father or a big, nice house, scriptures or a cool toy, etc. Read Genesis 25:29-34 and discuss how we need to keep our focus on eternal things and choose things that matter most, rather than things that give us instant gratification.

## 3. Genesis 26

Read Genesis 26 and summarize it for your family, emphasizing the verses where the Lord talks to Isaac and how Isaac responds. Then, act out the story of Isaac digging wells, his interactions with the king, and the friends he makes. Each person can play a different character in the story. After acting out the story, talk with your family about how we are blessed when we obey Heavenly Father. Sing "Quickly I'll Obey" (Children's Songbook, p. 197B).
