PRINTING

The majority of our downloads are formatted to print on 8.5x11" paper unless otherwise noted. You may print at home or a local print shop. We recommend using a recent version of Adobe Acrobat PDF Reader to view and print your files. It is available for free online. If you run into problems with pages being cut off, select "fit to page" in your print dialogue box to make sure it fits on your page correctly.

To print large page sizes (anything larger than 8.5x11"), we recommend going to a local print shop like Kinko's, Staples, AlphaGraphics, etc. and ask them to print your file as a black and white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big, fun and fairly inexpensive.

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Blessing Counter Sign

GENESIS 18:10-14; 21:2-3

Read Genesis 18:10-14 with your family. Ask the question from verse 14. “Is anything too hard for the Lord?”

Then, read Genesis 21:2-3 and discuss how the promise the Lord made to Sarah and Abraham was fulfilled. Testify that Heavenly Father always keeps His promises. Sometimes His blessings don’t come when we want them, but they always come. If you feel comfortable, share a personal experience about this with your children.

Talk about some blessings you’ve noticed from the Lord. Some may have come from making promises with Him, while others are simply because Heavenly Father loves you. Count your blessings as a family and use the following printable to keep track of how many blessings you notice. Laminate the printable and update your count throughout the week.

To end the activity, say a family prayer to thank Heavenly Father for all the blessings you’ve noticed—and for the ones you haven’t.
