PRINTING

Most of our downloads are formatted to print on 8.5x11" paper unless otherwise noted. You may print them at home or at a local print shop. We recommend using the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader to view and print your files. It is available for a free trial online.

If you experience issues with pages being cut off, select "Fit to Page" in your print dialog box to ensure the file prints correctly.

For larger page sizes (anything bigger than 8.5x11"), we recommend printing at a local print shop such as a UPS or FedEx store. Ask them to print your file as a black-and-white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big, fun, and fairly inexpensive.

If the print shop staff asks about your rights to reproduce this work, refer to the copyright release below. You can also tell them you downloaded these files for personal use from comefollowmefhe.com, and they can verify printing rights there.
