PRINTING

Most of our downloads are formatted to print on 8.5x11" paper unless otherwise noted. You may print them at home or at a local print shop. We recommend using the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader to view and print your files. It is available for a free trial online.

If you experience issues with pages being cut off, select "Fit to Page" in your print dialog box to ensure the file prints correctly.

For larger page sizes (anything bigger than 8.5x11"), we recommend printing at a local print shop such as a UPS or FedEx store. Ask them to print your file as a black-and-white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big, fun, and fairly inexpensive.

If the print shop staff asks about your rights to reproduce this work, refer to the copyright release below. You can also tell them you downloaded these files for personal use from comefollowmefhe.com, and they can verify printing rights there.

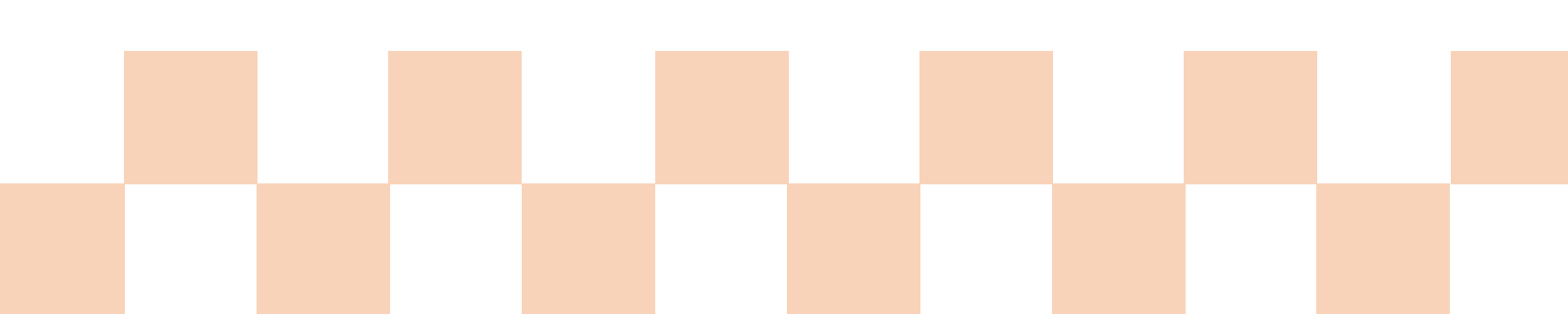
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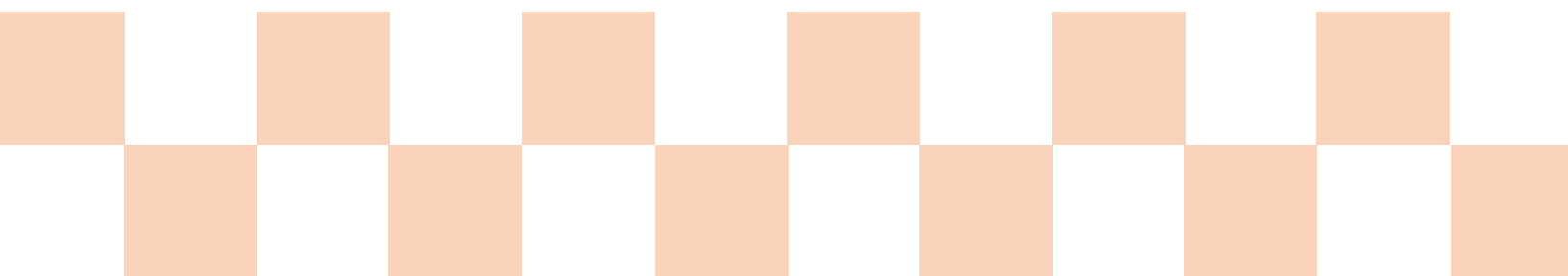

THINK FAST GAME

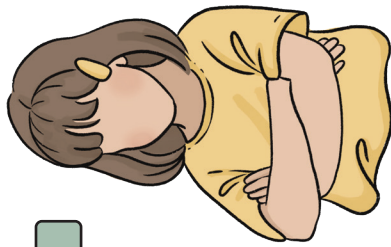
Print and cut out all the playing cards. For best results, print on cardstock for added durability.

HOW TO PLAY

1. Deal the deck face down into equally sized stacks—one for each player.
2. Starting with the player to the dealer's left, players take turns flipping the top card of their stack face up in the center of the table.
3. When a player places a card that matches the first card played, all players race to slap the pile. The first to slap it wins the entire stack.
4. The winner shuffles the pile and places it at the bottom of their own stack.
5. If someone slaps a non-matching card, they must give one card from their own stack to the player who played the last card.
6. If a player runs out of cards, they may still slap in to win a pile. If they lose the slap, they're out of the game.
7. The last player with all the cards wins!
