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PRINTING

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If you experience issues with pages being cut off, select "Fit to Page" in your print dialog box to ensure the file prints correctly.

For larger page sizes (anything bigger than 8.5x11"), we recommend printing at a local print shop such as a UPS or FedEx store. Ask them to print your file as a black-and-white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big, fun, and fairly inexpensive.

"You are my sunshine!" Attach to a lemon, a yellow treat, or even a yellow chapstick.

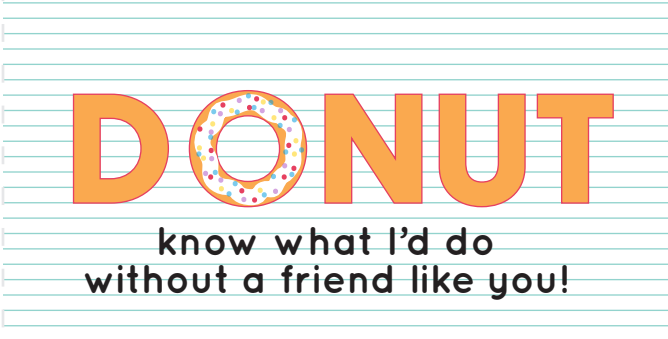
"My heart bursts..." Attach to Starbursts.
