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Works of God Activity

In Psalms 77, we learn about the importance of recognizing the works of God in our lives. In the talk “God’s Intent Is to Bring You Home,” we learn that God is in “relentless pursuit” of us. As we have faith and keep the commandments, we can see how He is helping and blessing us.

Follow these instructions to play the game:

1. Discuss some challenges you have faced in your lives and write them down on the roadblocks.
2. Talk about how God has worked in your lives to help remove those roadblocks, and write those blessings or help on the circles.
3. Cut out the roadblocks and set them up.
4. Cut out the circles and crumple them into balls.
5. Take turns flicking the balls at the roadblocks to knock them down!
