PRINTING

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If you experience issues with pages being cut off, select "Fit to Page" in your print dialog box to ensure the file prints correctly.

For larger page sizes (anything bigger than 8.5x11"), we recommend printing at a local print shop such as a UPS or FedEx store. Ask them to print your file as a black-and-white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big, fun, and fairly inexpensive.

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Jesus Is... Four Corners

ISAIAH 40:11, 29-31; 41:10-13, 17-18

Jesus Christ provides many things, but for the Israelites in captivity, these passages offered comfort, hope, love, and strength. Read Isaiah 40:11, 29-31 and Isaiah 41:10-13, 17-18. Talk about how Jesus is a source of comfort in your life today. Share ways He has shown His love to you personally. Spend time memorizing and discussing these four important traits of Christ: comfort, hope, love, and strength.

After your discussion, play the “Jesus Is...” Four Corners game to help your family remember these special truths.

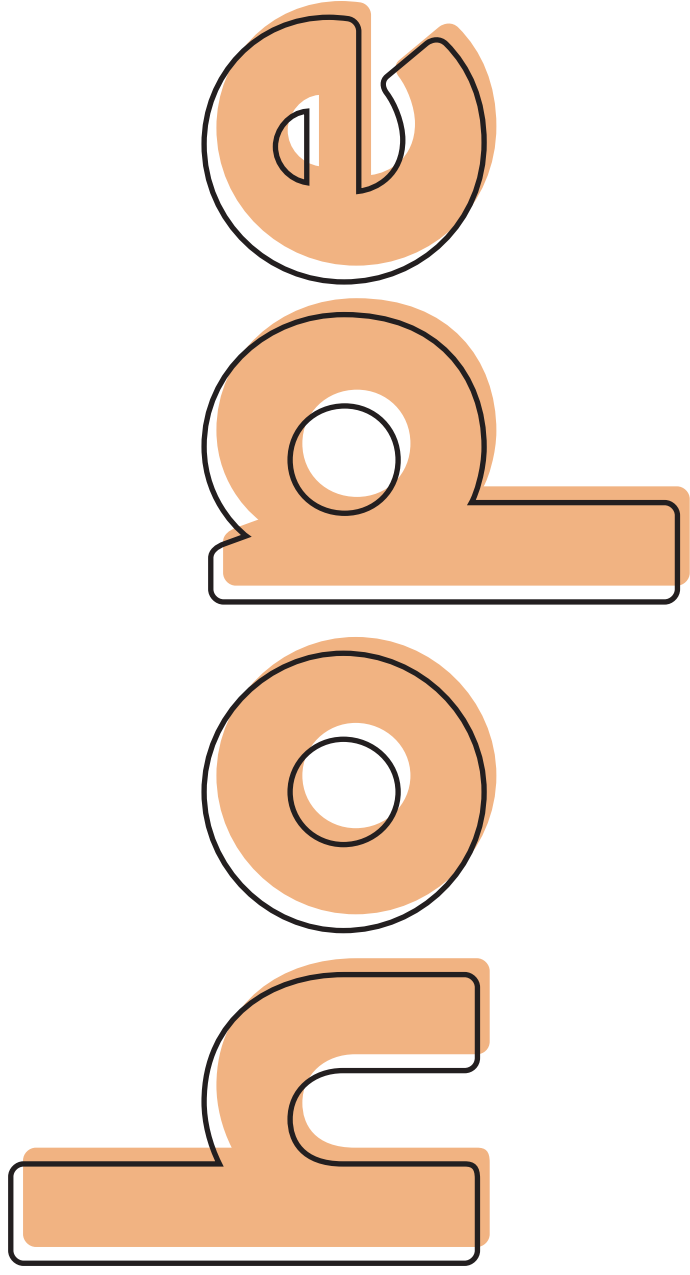
HOW TO PLAY

Print and hang the four posters—Comfort, Hope, Love, and Strength—in the four corners of a room.

Choose one person to be the counter. They will close their eyes and count to 10 or 20 while the rest of the family picks a corner to stand in. When the counter finishes counting, they call out, “Jesus is...” and choose one of the four traits. Anyone standing in that corner sits out. Continue playing until one person remains, or choose someone who was recently out to be the next counter.

When the game ends, review what you learned about Jesus Christ. Talk about how He provides comfort, hope, love, and strength. End by sharing your testimony of a time when you felt one of these blessings from Him.
