PRINTING

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If you experience issues with pages being cut off, select "Fit to Page" in your print dialog box to ensure the file prints correctly.

For larger page sizes (anything bigger than 8.5x11"), we recommend printing at a local print shop such as a UPS or FedEx store. Ask them to print your file as a black-and-white "engineer print" or "blueprint." These larger prints are big, fun, and fairly inexpensive.

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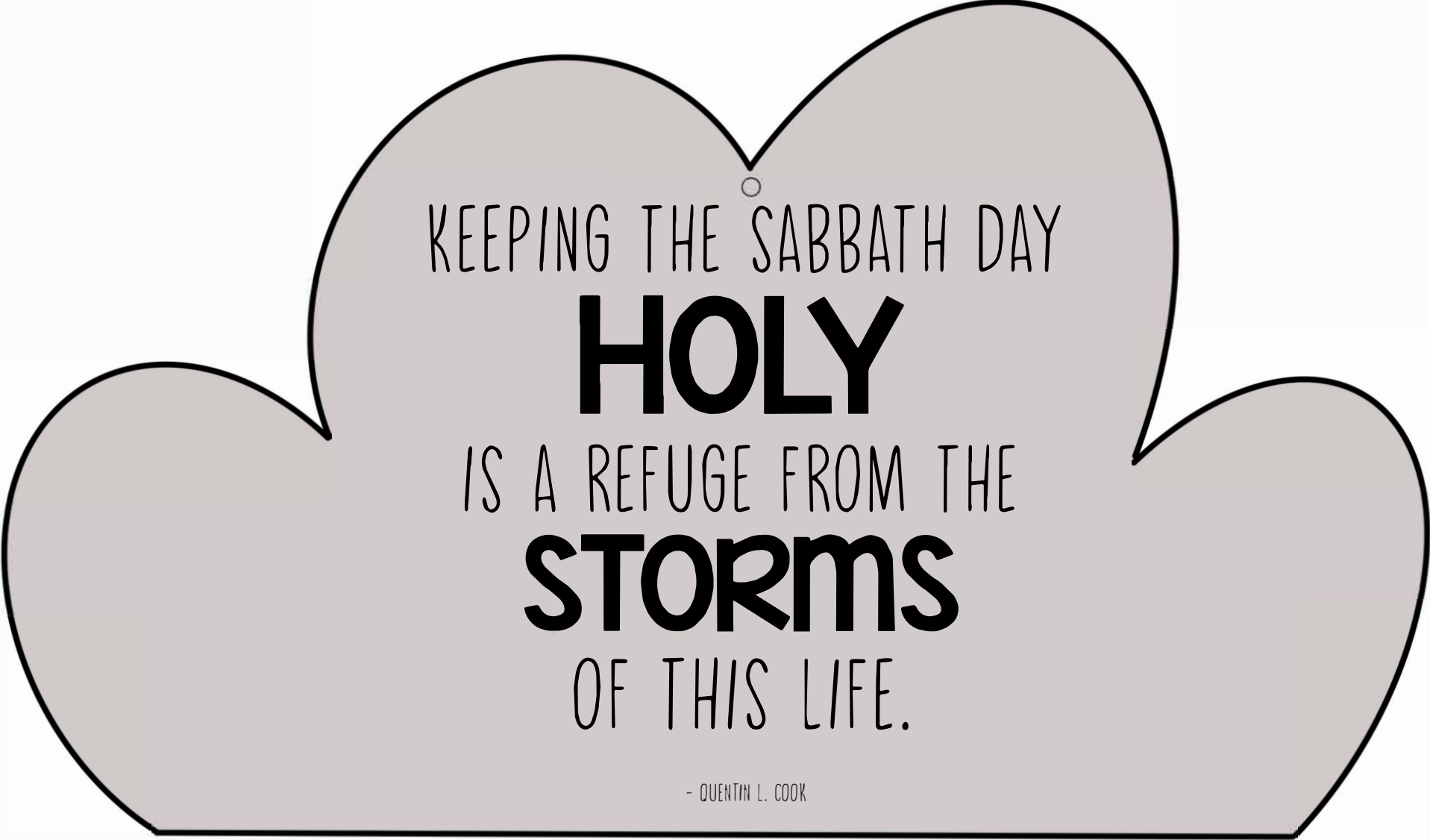
Sabbath Day Mobile

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out the cloud, umbrella, and raindrops.
2. Tie a string through the hole at the top of the storm cloud.
3. Tape a string to the back center of the cloud and attach the umbrella to the end of that string.
4. Tape six strings of varying lengths along the bottom of the cloud. Attach a raindrop to the end of each string.
5. Discuss with the children some of the things they do every day except Sunday. Write one activity on each raindrop.

Examples: going to school, working, watching television, shopping, participating in extracurricular activities.
